Budget Autotest Class 5 Regulations

Cars Eligible—Any production car with engine capacity up to and including 1600cc.
(Competitors are reminded that anyone that does not have a full RTA License will be restricted to 1400cc as per MSA rules (M11—11.3)).

Engine—Engines are to be to the standard manufacturers specification but air filters and exhaust systems are free. Exhaust must remain in the standard layout. Forced induction is not permitted.

Gearbox—To be to the standard manufacturers specification. LSD's are not permitted.

Brakes—Must remain to the standard size and calliper design. Vehicles with rear discs may be changed to drums but only from a vehicle of the same model.

Suspension and Steering—Must be to the manufacturers original specification. Coilovers and quick racks are not permitted.

Body—Must remain to the manufacturers design, all bumpers, doors and trim must remain. Vehicles can be lightened but only internally (i.e. door internals can be cut out) but all opening doors must be able to work as the manufacturer intended. Glass must remain in position but may be replaced with Perspex (min thickness 4mm).

Interior—Interior trim may be removed but the dashboard must remain in the factory position. Driver's seat must remain in the factory position.

Wheels and Tyres—Wheel sizes and materials must be to manufacturers specification.

Any vehicles deemed by the committee to not be in keeping with the spirit of the class will not be eligible.
